Parents,

Welcome back to a new school year. Here is the outline of what Five Yellow will be studying the month of October.

Language Arts

Week of October 4th, 2009

We will be reading **Nico's Trip**; this story is in Moving into English pages 18 – 27. In Grammar we will be studying written convections using teacher and internet resources. We will write paragraphs, focusing on using the correct writing convections. Students will review the manner of writing journal entries; they will write about themselves, their families, homes, nationalities and their favorite hobbies. We will also practice how to choose a Main Idea out of short texts.

Week of October 11th, 2009

We will continue and finish the **Nico's Trip**. In Grammar we will continue studying how to apply basic convections in writing. We will also begin to examine Nouns. You can find this on pages 123-127. We will continue to write paragraphs. We will put two paragraphs together about themselves and practice cursive writing.

Week of October 18th, 2009

This week we will read the stories from Spectrum Series for Comprehension. In Grammar we continue with the unit on Nouns. This is found in the Language Handbook pgs 123-127 and 129-131. In writing, we will write two paragraphs, using a story map.

Week of October 25th, 2009

We will read "**My place On the Map**"; this story is in Moving into English pages 30-37. In writing we will continue to write and publish paragraphs using correct punctuation, capital letters and full stops. In grammar we will continue studying nouns on pages 123-127. Students will be tested in spelling this week using vocabulary from: "**Nico's Trip**" vocabulary. Students will be given the word list a week in advance.

Math

Week of October 4th

We will be working on addition and addition stories. We will also do some worksheets on missing addends. As well as learning number bonds to 10 and 20. This is in the Saxon Math book in lesson 1-5 and lesson 11. We will continue learning our number bonds to 10 and 20. Students will have a class work assessment on Thursdays.

Week of October 11th

This week children will review subtraction; addition and subtraction fact families. Children will learn to subtract two, 3 digit numbers and use addition to check their answers. They will also begin learning about finding missing addends in subtraction number sentences. They will be working on lesson 6, 12 and 14 in the Saxon math books.

Week of October 18th

We will begin lesson 4 in our Saxon math books learning about place value and complete some worksheets. The aim is for the children to identify the place value of a digit in a number.

Week of October 25th

Students will be working on lesson 27-29 Multiplication as Repeated Addition.

SCIENCE

Week of October 4th and 11th

We will be studying the Earth and Space. This is in the earth and beyond, **Steck- Vaughn** series pages 89 - 97. We will be looking at the earth, learn about the earth's rotation and how it effects day and night, and will also do the exercises that follow each section.

Week of October 18th

We will continue to learn about the earth and space. This will be on pages 98-102. Focusing on how the earth is one of several planets and about our solar system. Children will give a brief presentation to the class about a planet in the solar system. We will start building a Solar System Model

Week of October 25th

We will be studying "Earth and beyond". Students will learn about the stars and their fixed positions in the sky using multiple internet and teacher's resources.
