Welcome back! Hope you have enjoyed your holiday break and are ready to work hard in this New Year. As follows is the study program for grade five yellow for the month of January.

Language Arts

Week of January 3

Reading: Continue Cleaning Up the River, *Moving into English* pages 76-81.

Students will have a reading test on Thursday January 7. (Vocabulary and comprehension of Cleaning up the River, *Moving into English* pages 76-81)

Writing: To write about a great memory or family story or a special family trip.

Grammar: To learn about pronouns and antecedents, *Language Handbook* pages 135-137.

Spelling: *Harcourt Collections Spelling Practice Book* pages 34 and 35. Students will learn the spelling words every Sunday. Please review daily with them the words to ensure they are ready for the tests on Wednesday. Students will read a book weekly. They will fill in a story map in their reading log. Students will also read a library book every other week and write on their library log.

Week of January 10

Reading: The Spider Soup, *Moving into English* pages 82 - 85.

Writing: To write and publish a final copy of their story.

Grammar: To learn about subject and object pronoun, *Language Handbook* pages 138-140.

Spelling: *Harcourt Collections Spelling Practice Book* pages 36 and 37.

Week of January 17

Reading: Spider Soup, *Moving into English* pages 82-87.

Writing: To write a persuasive paragraph. Students will write a paragraph to convince the audience to agree with the opinion and to take action- reasons to join English class.

Grammar: To learn about possessive pronouns, *Language Handbook* pages 141--143

Spelling: *Harcourt Collections Spelling Practice Book* pages 38 and 39.

Week of January 24

Reading: Teams At Work, *Moving into English* pages 88-89.

Writing: Book review- writing a literature review article. Choosing any of the text they have read, they can write and design a review article.

Grammar: To learn about adjectives and articles, *Language Handbook* pages 144--146

Spelling: *Harcourt Collections Spelling Practice Book* pages 40 and 41.

Math

Week of January 3: Division .To practice both short and long division as well as remainders. **Division Test – January 11**

Week of January 10: Fraction concepts, we will learn new vocabulary (numerator/denominator), what a fraction is and how it's used.

Week of January 17: Fraction concepts: recap our knowledge of fractions and learn to addition and subtract using fractions.

Week of January 24: Decimal concepts: introduction to a decimal its forms uses and it place on the number line. **Fraction Test- February 1**

Lessons are from the *Saxon math* series and *math spectrum workbooks*.

Science

Week of January 3: Materials of Earth-this week we will learn new vocabulary and concept. We will learn about minerals and the igneous rocks.

Week of January 10: This week, we will learn about sedimentary and metamorphic rocks.

Week of January 17: This week, we will learn about ores and fossils.

Week of January 24: This week, we will learn about coal and petroleum.
