As follows is the study program for grade five yellow for the month of APRIL.

Language Arts

Week 29th March

Reading: The way west- one girls story or Jerry Pinckney: achiever of dreams, 152-162 and 218-228 Moving into English.

Writing: Persuasive paragraph- writing to any of their teachers or parents persuading them to change something or give them something new.

Grammar: sentence parts, subject, predicates, complete and simple subjects.

Spelling: Collections spelling practice book pages 22 and 23.

Week 3rd April:

Writing: publish their work and refine their writing.

Week 3rd April: This week we will be continuing with perimeters and introducing the concept of area and its formula. The children will begin their math project on surface areas and measures.

Week 12 April: Start learning about Area and how to measure area spaces and practice using the area formula.

Week 19th April: Complete our class project on surface area and measure the perimeter and surface area of major areas around the school.

Science
